Overview

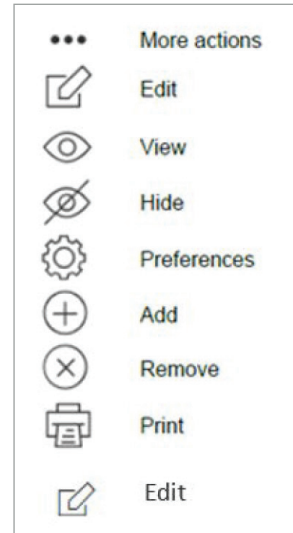
Pages are redesigned to reduce clicks and improve productivity. Menus are aggregated so only pertinent information is displayed.

The menu previously labeled as **Transfers & Payments** is renamed **Money Movement**.

Icons are used to help users easily identify actions/options. Icons are used in place of hyperlinks and provide a consistent user experience.

The primary icons are listed to the right.

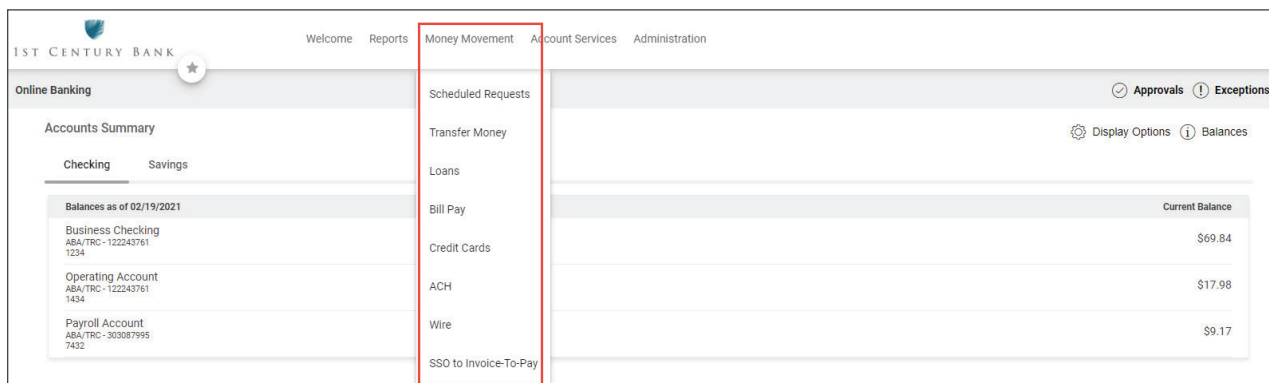

Money Movement – What is Different?

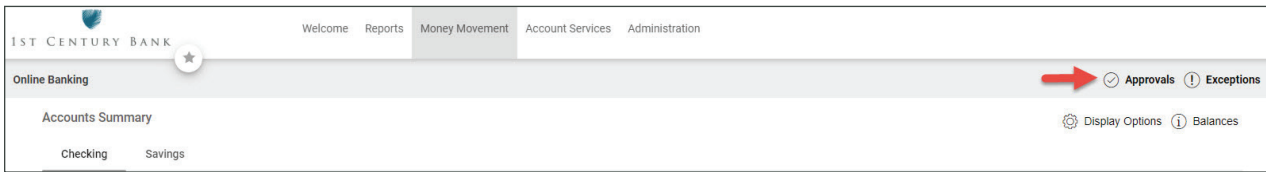
Navigation Updates

Options are reorganized to appear across the top of page, and items are consolidated into tabs to easily access only what is needed. Radio buttons are replaced with drop-down boxes.



Approvals

To access approvals for any service, navigate to the **Approvals** link housed at the top right of each page instead of under individual services. This makes it easier for users to access all pending approvals in one location.



Transfers

- All transfer functions (**Internal Transfer** and **Multiple Account Transfer**) are consolidated under the **Transfer Money** menu
- Sub menu headings display horizontally on the page for easier viewing and navigation
- Radio buttons are replaced with drop-down menus

ACH

- ACH menu items are easily located on the **Make ACH Payment/Manage Templates** page
 - Options are listed horizontally across top of page instead of left side menu
 - **View completed ACH transactions** is renamed **History**
 - **Approvals** are consolidated in a single location at the top right side of every screen
- **Upload File** – Once files are uploaded, the **File Upload Status/Approve Files** screen appears automatically, allowing the user to easily approve or transmit file(s)

Wire

For International Wires, a toggle button allows the user to select whether additional intermediary information is needed. If Yes, intermediary fields are displayed; if No, the additional content remains collapsed.
